

Turnstile policy

Wembley Stadium operates a random but targeted spectator search policy unless the threat level for the stadium is heightened or any specific intelligence is received from the Metropolitan Police.

Prohibited items

The following articles must not be brought within the Ground: knives, fireworks, smoke canisters, air-horns, flares, weapons, dangerous or hazardous items, laser devices, bottles, glass vessels, cans, poles & any article that might be used as a weapon and/or compromise public safety.

Any person in possession of such items will be refused entry to the Ground.

- Any article that might be used as a weapon be deemed to be offensive or abusive, or compromise public safety, will be confiscated & or reported to the police.
- Unlicensed musical instruments: trumpets, drums & other devices capable of causing a disturbance or nuisance
- Flag poles greater than 1m in length
- Flares
- Bottles, glass vessels, cans, flasks
- Frisbees & similar items
- Dangerous or hazardous items
- Illegal substances
- Explosives or ammunition; fireworks
- Knives, blades or other weapons
- Firearms
- Scooters, skateboards or other skates
- Laser devices
- Smoke canisters
- Signs or items with corporate or inappropriate branding
- Unauthorised fliers
- Spray paint, large industrial style “permanent” marker pens
- Prams / push chairs
- Transmitting devices
- Professional cameras & recording devices (This applies to cameras that have interchangeable lenses)
- Large Suitcases, laptops & back packs
- Illegal merchandise items
- Water bottles (need to have the ability to decant)
- Illegal charity collection utensils
- Motor bike helmets
- Umbrellas
- Darts
- Hampers & Cold Boxes
- Air Horns
- Alcohol
- Animals (Except service dogs & guide dogs)
